"BID" stands for Business Improvement District. The West Vernor & Springwells BID maintains, improves and enhances the shopping district to create a clean, comfortable and secure place for residents, customers and visitors to enjoy. The property owners in the BID pay a yearly fee to help pay for BID services. Property owners elect a Board of Directors who determine cost-effective ways of investing BID funds to create visible positive change in the business district.




